# **Iverson Bell Award**

# **Eligibility**

Nominees may be an individual within a college/school of veterinary medicine or external to a college/school of veterinary medicine. The individual need not be a veterinarian.

### Who may nominate

Any individual employed at an AAVMC member institution.

#### What to submit

- 1. Nomination letter addressing the award criteria (see below)
- 2. Supporting documentation, not to exceed 10 single-sided pages

### Award criteria

- 1. A demonstrated commitment to promoting diversity and inclusion in academic veterinary medicine through contributions that may have impact in any area-college, local area or region, state and/or national arenas.
- Played a significant role in the recruitment, development, and retention of pre-vet and DVM students, faculty, residents and interns from underrepresented or disadvantaged and/or marginalized groups.
- 3. Included and promoted diversity in the veterinary medical profession through the inclusion/infusion of diversity issues in the college environment through programming and curriculum additions.

### Award committee

The AAVMC Diversity Committee appoints the award committee from among its members.
